Daylight saving time begins March 8 and marks the regular change in local irrigation rules.



Don't let irrigation drown your utility bill. Follow these tips to keep both your lawn and wallet green:

- Water before 10 a.m. or after 4 p.m.
- Water for less than one hour per zone.
- Water only on days specified by county irrigation rules:

Odd-numbered addresses	Wed. and/or Sat.
Even-numbered addresses	Thurs. and/or Sun.
Businesses	Tues. and/or Friday

Natural gas leaks not only drive up your utility bill, they can also be dangerous. Identify possible natural gas leaks in your home by being aware of the following warning signs:

- Unusual rotten egg like odors
- Hissing or roaring sounds
