2.	Customer will not be contacted prior to delivery, and will designate a delivery location that is accessible to the delivery vehicles.	
3.	Customer will provide a street map to the service address, and a property diagram identifying the exact location where the load is to be delivered. (Space provided at bottom of page.)	
4.	Customer releases GRU and its contractors from any liability or cleanup.	
5.	GRU will deliver one load of coarse wood chips, which may consist of varying combinations of wood, leaves and pine needles, to the above customer's address and delivery location free of charge. GRU notes that the wood chips are not landscape quality, and recommends that they be used as ground cover away from the house, for unpaved driveways, mulch piles, pathways, or parking areas.	
6.	Generally, wood chip delivery will be dependent on where the crews are working. Efforts are made to evenly distribute the wood chips throughout the service area. During peak seasons (spring and summer) there is often a several month wait for delivery.
